

1 Contents of the packages

- 1 package for the steering support
- 1 package for the steering wheel with the following elements:



Wheel + Pedals

Fixing kit

Power supply, power cord and computer cord

□ Open the support box.





Take out tools from **B Pocket**. In the **A pocket** you will find the kit for pedals bracket.

2 Preparation


Unscrew a little the plate with tools (flat key and Allen key).

□ Adjust the steering wheel support perpendicular to the mast, then tighten it firmly; the screw will be inaccessible once the steering wheel is mounted.



3 Steering wheel connections

□ Connect the different cables following this diagram before fixing the steering wheel on the plate.



From Left to Right

- 1- Power socket
- 2- USB-C computer connection
- 3- Optional socket
- 4- RJ11 pedals

Use the guides and the strap to position the cables without risk of pinching/damage during installation on the support.



4 Attachment

1.1 Steering wheel deck

Place screw B inside thread C under the steering wheel.
Adjust the steering wheel on the mast with part A.



2.1 Pedals

- \Box Place the rubbers on the red bar as shown in the image below.
- □ Position the pedal attachment on the steering wheel support.
- □ Tighten the screws halfway to allow movement of the pedal attachment.



Unpack the pedals and position it as shown in the image below.
Hold the pedals by screwing the fixing bar around them with the Allen wrench.








5 Computer instructions

Install the Thrustmaster's driver for T128 (it is the same for both T150/T128 and TMX steering wheel)
Open the Start Menu (Windows key on the keyboard) and enter "usb"


in the search bar.

- □ Select "Configure USB game controllers".
- Click on "Thrustmaster T128 Racing Wheel" and "Properties".



 $\hfill \Box$ In the "Test Input" tab, select the "Combined" option. ".

- □ In the "Gain stettings" tab, set the "overall Strength of all forces" option to 100%.
- □ In the "Auto center settings" tab, select the "by the wheel" option and set the value to 70%
